## Of the 36 graduates of the Class of 2019...

- 17% are attending Sonoma State University
- 17% are attending other CSU's (Sacramento, East Bay, San Francisco, Humboldt, Stanislaus)
- **11%** are attending a UC (Berkeley, Davis)
- **3%** are attending the military (Marines)
- 52% are attending Santa Rosa Junior College

#### **College Attendance**

Of the graduates...

- **45%** are attending a 4-year University
- 58% met the subject requirements to attend a UC/CSU County Average: 24%\*
- **50%** were accepted into a 4-year University
- 97% are attending a 2 or 4-year University National Average: 51%\*
- 183 college applications were completed

### **High School Academics**

- 100% of graduates were AVID students during their 12th grade year
- **81%** of graduates took the ACT and/or SAT
- 77% of graduates took at least one AP Course

#### **Financial Aid**

- 78% of graduates (28 students) completed the process to obtain financial assistance from the Roseland Scholarship Program. Approximately \$52,000 is scheduled to be awarded
- **72%** of graduates (**26** students) received other scholarship funding from the local community and their college. Approximately **\$36,600** was awarded to students
- **97%** of graduates completed the FAFSA or Dream Act

#### **College Experience Activities**

- **18-19 College Visits:** Santa Rosa Junior College, UC Davis, Dominican University, CSU East Bay, San Francisco State University
- Summer Trip 2019: Cal Poly SLO, UC Santa Barbara, California Art Institute, UCLA, CSU Monterey Bay, UC Santa Cruz
- **Discovery and Shadow Day:** Special partnership with Sonoma State allows 9th graders to participate in Discovery Day and 11th graders to experience Shadow Day
