Congratulations to the **FIRST** High School Graduating Class of Roseland Collegiate Prep!

Of the 47 graduates of the Class of 2018...

- **13%** are attending Sonoma State University
- **9%** are attending other CSU's (*Cal Poly-Pomona, East Bay, Monterey Bay*)
- **17%** are attending a UC (*Berkeley, UCLA, Riverside, Santa Barbara, Davis*)
- **6%** are attending private or out-of-state universities
- **6%** are enlisting in the military (*Coast Guard, Air Force, Marines*)
- **49%** are attending SRJC

College Attendance

Of the graduates...

- **45%** are attending a 4-year University
- **51%** met the subject requirements to attend a UC/CSU *County Average: 24%**
- **83%** were accepted into a 4-year University
- **94%** are attending a 2 or 4-year University *National Average: 51%**
- **213** college applications were completed

High School Academics

- **96%** of graduates were AVID students during their 12th grade year
- **94%** of graduates took the ACT and/or SAT
- **64%** of graduates took at least one AP Exam

Financial Aid

- **83%** of graduates (**39** students) have access to financial assistance from the Roseland Scholarship Program. Approximately **\$24,500** is scheduled to be awarded
- **55%** of graduates (**24** students) received other scholarship funding from the local community and their college. Approximately **\$55,860** was awarded to students
- **87%** of graduates completed the FAFSA or Dream Act

College Experience Activities

- **17-18 College Visits:** Sonoma State University, Santa Rosa Junior College, Dominican, San Jose State
- **Summer Trip 2018:** Chico State, Southern Oregon University, University of Oregon, Oregon State, Western Oregon, University of Portland, Portland State, Humboldt State
- **Discovery and Shadow Day:** Special partnership with Sonoma State allows 9th Graders to participate in Discovery Day and 11th graders to experience Shadow Day
