Of the 38 graduates of the Class of 2020...

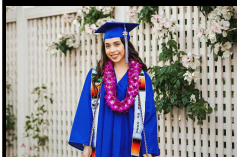
- 21% are attending Sonoma State University
- 5% are attending other CSU (*Sacramento*)
- 16% are attending a UC (*Berkeley, Riverside, Merced*)
- 5% are attending private or out-of-state universities
- 50% are attending Santa Rosa Junior College
- 3% are attending military



College Attendance

Of the graduates...

- 47% are attending a 4-year University
- 53% met the subject requirements to attend a UC/CSU *County Average: 24%**
- 55% were accepted into a 4-year University
- 97% are attending a 2 or 4-year University *National Average: 51%**
- 159 college applications were completed



High School Academics

- 95% of graduates were AVID students during their 12th grade year
- 79% of graduates took at least one AP Course



Financial Aid

\$59,138 is scheduled to be awarded through the Roseland Charter School Scholarship Fund during the 2020-2021 school year.
100% of graduates who qualified received support from the Roseland Scholarship Fund.

\$23,100 is scheduled to be awarded to RCP students through outside scholarship funding sources during the 2020-2021 school year.

84% of graduates completed the FAFSA or Dream Act

Alumni College Persistence

Of the students who attended college after high school graduation and who have enrollment data in the National Student Clearinghouse:

78% 1-year persistences rate (Class of 2018) *National Average: 69%**
