## CLASS OF 2019 ACCOMPLISHMENTS



### Of the 106 graduates of the Class of 2019...

- **14%** are attending Sonoma State University
- **14%** are attending other CSU's (*Chico, Long Beach, Sacramento, East Bay, San Jose, Stanislaus*)
- **15%** are attending a UC (*Davis, Riverside, Merced, UCLA, Santa Barbara, San Diego*)
- **2%** are attending private or out-of-state universities
- **55%** are attending Santa Rosa Junior College or other Junior Colleges

### College Attendance

Of the graduates...

- **45%** are attending a 4-year University
- **61%** met the subject requirements to attend a UC/CSU *County Average: 24%\**
- **58%** were accepted into a 4-year University
- **100%** are attending a 2 or 4-year University *National Average: 51%\**
- **422** college applications were completed

### High School Academics

- **93%** of graduates were AVID students during their 12th grade year
- **82%** of graduates took the ACT or SAT
- **72%** of graduates took at least one AP Course

### Financial Aid

- **88%** of graduates (93 students) have completed the process to obtain financial assistance from the Roseland Charter Scholarship Program. Approximately **\$200,000** is scheduled to be awarded
- **55%** of graduates (58 graduates) received other scholarship funding from the local community and their college. Approximately **\$161,850** was awarded to students
- **97%** of graduates completed the FAFSA or Dream Act

### Through College Mentor Program

- **216** mentees and **196** mentors (2012-2019)
- **14%** increase in students graduating from college (*first year of Through College cohort compared to the first non-mentor cohort*)

### Alumni College Persistence

Of the students who attended college after high school graduation and who have enrollment data in the National Student Clearinghouse:

- 1-year Persistence Rate: **84%** *National Average: 69%\**
- 2-year Persistence Rate: **73%**
- 6 Year or Less Post-secondary Graduation Rate:
  - **Class of: 2009: 32% 2010: 32% 2011: 47%**  
(2011 was the first class matched with Through College Mentors)
- **College Graduates: 134** (*beginning with the college class of 2012*)
